Note: Students concentrating in Applied Math-Biology apply for honors based on the appointment of their Thesis Advisor. If that advisor is in a Biology dept., please apply using this Biology application. Students whose thesis advisor is in Applied Mathematics should apply via Applied Math. Students whose advisor is not with either department can contact either Matthew Harrison or Dean Achilli for more information.

Concentrators in **Biochemistry** apply via Biochemistry advisors; **Computational Biology** students apply via CCMB; **Biomedical Engineering** concentrators proceed via Engineering.

As per University policy, students may not use the same thesis to gain honors in more than one concentration. If pursuing honors in two concentrations, the theses must be fully distinct in content.

Quality Grades:

Students who have earned a majority of "A" grades in courses required for the concentration and who are in good academic standing are eligible to apply for honors at the start of their penultimate (typically 7th) semester at Brown.

Courses not taken at Brown will not be included. Classes taken S/NC will count

as qualifying towards that majority if they are marked "S with distinction" indicating that had the student taken the course for a grade, the grade would have been an "A". Please note that "S with distinction" is not visible on the Brown transcript or in ASK. Please inquire with the Registrar or Student Affairs.) Grades earned in penultimate semester concentration courses will be accounted for in the determination of quality grades. Students with outdated declarations will not be evaluated until their ASK declaration has been updated and approved.

Honors Applicants:

The completed application will be forwarded to your Thesis Advisor and Second Reader—be sure that BOTH signatures have been submitted via this form by the first Monday in October for May graduates; and by the first Friday in March for December graduates. Applicants will be notified of acceptance as an honors candidate within two weeks after the application deadline.
